“AI: A Bigger Threat Than an Opportunity” Sparks Fiery Debate

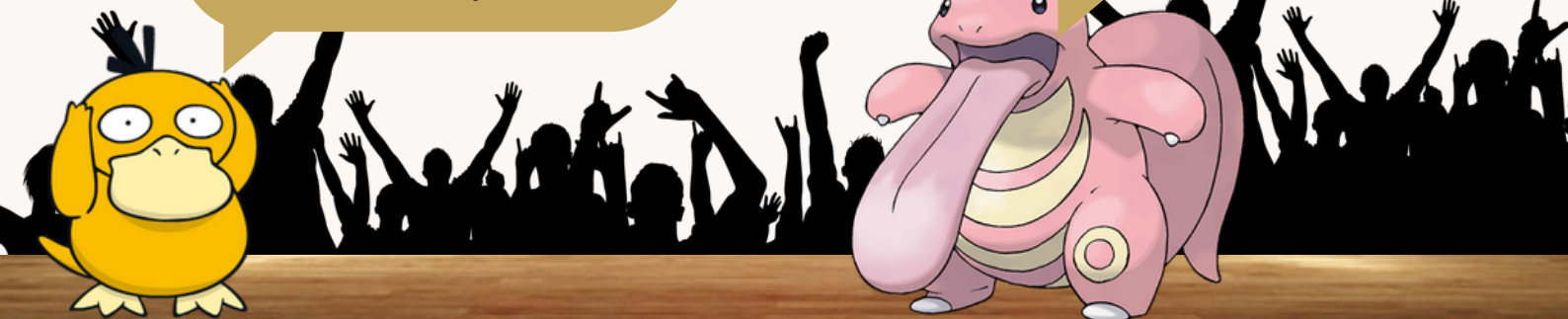

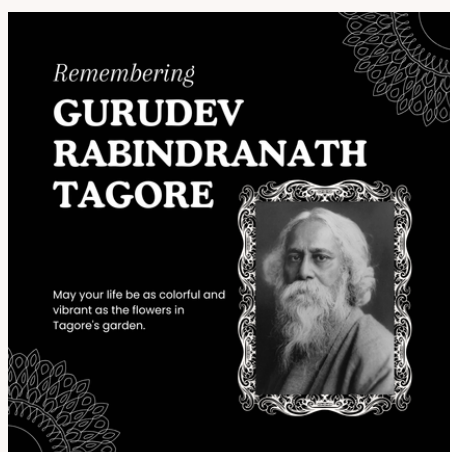
The programme concluded with the announcement of winners and the distribution of certificates. The Principal congratulated all the participants and encouraged them to continue improving their public speaking abilities.
